On the afternoon of the Crab Feast, the doors will open at 12:00 noon and the crabs will be served at 1:00 PM. Cost of the meal is \$65.00 for 1 adult, \$600.00 for a table of 10, and children 5 and under are free, but are required to have a ticket to assure adequate seating.

Tickets can be purchased individually or as a group. Each ticket sold will correspond to a specific table at the feast. In order to ensure you are seated with friends, we ask you to please mail your order together in the same envelope or make a note on your order form. Each rectangle table seats ten (10) people.
