From the East – Keith Geise, WM

I had the pleasure of attending our Grand Lodge communication and sharing fellowship with great brothers. One topic that came up was the continued decline in our membership. In Delaware our rolls are being reduced yearly by approximately 100 members and our membership is not getting younger. This is not a new trend as it has been happening for years. Even in our lodge there is a noticeable lack of candidates. To my knowledge we do not have any petitions in the pipeline, and I honestly cannot remember when the last petition was read.

Since entering our lodge several years ago, I mainly see the same approximately 20 brothers.

Brothers we are now to a point that a lack of attendance and participation is a direct threat to the officer line. For the past several years we have had brothers step up and go above and beyond to keep the line moving. This is not sustainable or is an enjoyable experience. It just becomes another job. The progression through the line is supposed to be a learning experience and creates memories that brings us all closer.

Temple Lodge #9 has lodge meetings bi-weekly for 10 out of 12 months. That's 24 meetings (with some exceptions), in my experience if something is important to you, you will make time. Brothers we all have the exact same 24 hours in a day as measured by the 24-inch gauge. It is understandable that things do occasionally get in the way, or life demands we go in a different direction but without your support and attendance the lodge will eventually fail.

There are districts less than 50 miles from us where the same people have been sitting in the chairs for years on end. Brothers that's not a lodge it's a business meeting.

I am asking each of you to take a serious look at your dedication to the craft. Reexamine your reasons for joining the fraternity and relight that fire.
